Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
There will be showers across many parts, though there is a chance of a drier corridor in part of the south. A few heavy prolonged showers are expected, especially in Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England. Temperatures will be near or a little below normal. It will feel cool in the south in the brisk wind.  
Tonight is expected to be rather cloudy with further showery outbreaks in the north, but in the south showers will become largely confined to windward coasts.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
It will stay showery, the showers merging into more prolonged rain in places. Overnight the showers should die down inland.
