Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A spell of persistent and fairly heavy rain will spread eastwards across the country, clearing during the afternoon. Colder, brighter conditions and blustery showers will follow quite quickly, with showers falling as sleet or snow over hills in the north of the UK by evening. Southwesterly winds will turn quite brisk during the day.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Further persistent rain is expected across southern Britain on Sunday morning, perhaps turning to sleet or snow before it clears to the east. Scattered sleet and snow showers will continue further north. It will be mostly fine on Monday but remain cold, with frost forming overnight.
