Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Many western and southern areas starting grey and damp with patchy rain or drizzle and fog over the hills. Drizzle should die out, then most places will be dry with some sunny spells, though some western coasts may stay grey and misty. It will become quite warm, especially in the south.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
It should remain dry in many areas, but with rather a lot of cloud for many. However, some bright or sunny intervals are likely in places, and it should be fairly warm. However, later on Friday, rain will spread southwards across northern areas, with clearer, colder weather to follow.
