

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Tuesday 27 Nov 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Northern Scotland should have a largely dry morning, but rain will push in later on. Otherwise rain over southwest Scotland, N.Ireland and northwest England initially will move southeast across most other parts during the day. Some drier, brighter weather will follow, but with rain returning to N.Ireland later. Mild.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain over central and southern England and Wales on Thursday morning will gradually clear southeastwards. Otherwise plenty of dry weather with sunny spells is expected. Largely cloudy on Friday with outbreaks of rain, and perhaps some heavy rain moving east during the day. Turning cooler and more showery thereafter.
