

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 01 Aug 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Largely dry in the southeast at first but elsewhere overnight rain continues,
becoming heavy at times. The rain migrates east with western and central
counties becoming dry by with this evening, and eastern parts drying out
overnight, although parts of Scotland and Northwest England may have
intermittent light rain during the night. Remaining rather windy in the north.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday starts dry with sunny spells for most of the UK before cloud thickens
from the west, and isolated light showers develop. A band of persistent rain
spreads from the west on Monday, affecting most parts by the end of the day.
