Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Saturday:- patchy rain or drizzle in the far northeast of Scotland, will die away while lingering for a time over Shetland. Elsewhere, generally dry with sunny periods, although some eastern coasts of England/Scotland/perhaps far southwest, cloudier. Chance of a few scattered showers across some eastern areas of Scotland/England for a time. Temperatures; a little above normal in the north, warm in the south, locally very warm in the southeast.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Largely fine and dry after a cloudy start in eastern areas on Sunday. Chance of a shower in Northern Ireland on Sunday, these heavier in the southwest and west on Monday. Warm or very warm, becoming hot in the south.
