

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain, sleet and snow is expected across Scotland with cold northeasterly winds. This will move south into northern England through the day. Elsewhere, scattered showers may be prolonged at times, although the south may be drier in the morning. Scotland and Northern Ireland will become brighter from the north, with some wintry showers.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain across the south, will turn to snow in places, mainly over hills on Wednesday. Further north it will be cold with wintry showers, mainly affecting the east. Strong northeasterly winds. Rain should clear on Thursday morning, leaving a largely dry, although cloudy day.
