Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be mainly dry day with sunny spells, though there will be some showers, mainly over northern parts of the UK. Feeling cooler for many compared to yesterday, especially across England and Wales. Turning cloudier across parts of Scotland overnight with outbreaks of rain developing here. Elsewhere will be dry with clear spells and turning chilly as a result.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Outbreaks of rain continuing across Scotland on Tuesday, moving into Northern Ireland and northern England later. Dry elsewhere, with some sunny spells. These outbreaks of rain will then move south on Wednesday, followed by a mix of sunshine and showers.
