

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A mild and windy day with gales developing through the Irish Sea and across northwestern parts of Scotland, as outbreaks of rain arrive in the north and west. Elsewhere, it will generally be cloudy with some brighter spells to the east of higher ground. Rain will arrive for all overnight, but it will turn significantly colder from the north.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Storm Caroline will bring storm force winds to Scotland on Thursday, with frequent snow showers. Elsewhere, early rain will clear to brighter but much colder weather. Friday remains windy and bitterly cold with frequent snow showers in the north and west.
