Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
It'll be a cold and dry start for many on Saturday morning with a patchy frost in some rural spots. However, a band of blustery rain and hill snow will affect northern parts of Scotland through the day. Elsewhere, it'll be a mostly dry afternoon with some sunny spells, before rain returns to the South West later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

There'll be a patchy frost to start on Sunday and Monday, with some fog patches around. Sunday will be dry for many with some sunshine, although there will also be a few showers around. Rain and strong winds will return again on Monday.
