Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Heavy rain in the southeast, gales in the south, and perhaps some wet snow briefly as the rain clears eastwards. Otherwise, frost and fog clearing, then sunshine and showers. Still feeling chilly. Further showers tonight, especially in the south and southwest. Frost and patchy fog elsewhere.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A chilly start to Monday with fog patches, and frost, especially in the north. Showers gradually becoming confined to the east throughout the day, becoming largely dry and bright in the west. Cloudy with outbreaks of rain in the north on Tuesday, drier and a little brighter in the south.
