

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 18 Jul 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Breezy and cloudy with outbreaks of rain for Scotland, Northern Ireland, Northern England and Wales. It should, however, turn drier and brighter in Northern Ireland and Scotland later. The rest of England will be mostly dry with variable amounts of cloud. Further rain for northern and western areas overnight, but staying largely dry for central and southern England.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain continues during Monday for Northern Ireland, Scotland, Wales, then later for western England. Elsewhere, drier and brighter, and very warm in the southeast. The rain spreads eastwards, mainly affecting England by Tuesday, turning brighter and fresher elsewhere with a few showers.
