

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Generally rather cloudy across many western and northern areas, with occasional rain or showers. Southern and eastern England will see the best of the sunshine, once any morning fog clears. Rain across western Scotland will turn heavy and persistent, and sink southeastwards into Northern Ireland, northern England and north Wales by dawn. Becoming windy in most areas.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Heavy rain will continue to slowly move southeastwards on Wednesday, but is unlikely to reach the far southeast until well into Thursday morning. Clearer and showery conditions will follow on, with winds easing for a time. It will continue to feel rather cold.
