Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Many places dry with sunny spells. Northern and eastern Scotland will be showery with sleet and snow at low-levels, turning to rain later. Scattered cloud and showers, some wintry, across central and eastern England. Strong northerly winds in eastern areas. Rather cold generally.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Mostly dry with sunny spells across much of England and Wales on both days with temperatures near normal, but some overnight frost. Breezy conditions and rain will spread south over northern parts on Wednesday, with some heavy rain and strong winds for northwest Scotland. More showery weather is likely in the north on Thursday. Rather cold there.
