Headline:

Wintry showers in the east, heavy snowfall likely for southeast.

This Evening and Tonight:

Dry in the west, but showers turning wintry in the east, and becoming frequent and heavy over E.Anglia and SE England.

Tuesday:

Cold, with snow showers in eastern counties spreading well inland on a strong east to northeast wind, some reaching other parts of England and Wales.

Outlook for Wednesday:

Mainly dry in the west, but further snow showers are likely in the east.
