Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Scotland will stay cloudy with rain at times, heaviest and most persistent in the east. However, western and later southern parts will be drier with perhaps a few brighter spells. Elsewhere, a mixture of sunny spells and scattered showers, the showers very heavy at times with hail, thunder and squally winds especially in the south and west. Temperatures mostly near normal.
Tonight, showers or longer spells of rain will affect northern and western areas while most central and east parts become mainly dry.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Becoming cooler but drier with sunny spells, isolated showers and mostly light northwesterly winds.
