General Situation

Pressure will remain high over the north, maintaining settled weather here. Elsewhere various lows and troughs will bring rain and some thundery showers at times.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, backing east or northeast later, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 2 to 4, increasing 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East 2 to 4 backing northeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 or 4, decreasing 2 or 3 later.

Slight, but smooth in firths of Forth and Tay.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4.

Slight becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 or 4, decreasing 2 or 3 later.

Slight or moderate becoming slight.

Rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Northeast backing north or northwest, 4 or 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight near shore.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.

Rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Thames estuary.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5 becoming westerly or northwesterly 2 to 4, then variable 4 or less later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 2 to 4, increasing 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, but smooth at first in west.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 to 6, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 2 to 4, increasing 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight becoming slight, occasionally moderate in east.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then southwest 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth in north.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, backing south or southeast later.

Slight, occasionally smooth in lyme bay.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4 backing northeast, then northwest, 2 to 4, backing southwest 3 to 5 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth in lyme bay, becoming moderate in west and southwest.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, mainly southwest, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then west or southwest 3 to 5

later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in southwest and later in west.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 to 5 becoming cyclonic 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 2 to 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then south or southwest 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4 backing northeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight, becoming smooth.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 4 or less.

Smooth.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4 backing northeast 4 or 5, veering east 2 to 4 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth, becoming smooth later.

Rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 2 to 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then south 2 to 4 later.

Smooth.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 2 to 4, becoming variable 4 or less, then east 3 to 5, decreasing 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain in south.

Good, occasionally moderate in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 2 to 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth, occasionally slight in north and south.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less for a time, occasionally 5 later in North Channel.

Smooth, occasionally slight in North Channel.
Occasional rain in south.
Good, occasionally moderate in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Easterly or northeasterly 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then southeasterly 2 to 4 later.
Smooth.
Fair.
Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
East, backing north for a time, 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later in northwest.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, becoming north 2 to 4 for a time, then southeast 3 to 5 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in southeast.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
High remaining anchored across your area through the period

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 in north
Slight, but smooth in lee shelter just east of Shetland
Mainly fair, occasional rain at first in north
Good, occasionally moderate at first in north

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 06 Jun until 1200 UTC on Monday 06 Jun:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 in north
Slight, but smooth in lee shelter just east of Shetland
Mainly fair
Mainly good

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 3 to 4, locally variable 1 or 2 in the far south for a time, becoming generally 4 to 5 by dusk, backing southwest to south 2 to 4 later.

Slight, locally smooth.

Isolated showers in the afternoon and evening, mainly in south, perhaps heavy and thundery near brittany coast rain and drizzle in the southwest of the area by late morning.

Good, occasionally moderate, perhaps locally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southwest 2 to 4, backing southeast for a time, veering southwest to west 3 to 5 by dawn, locally variable 1 to 3 mid-channel at times.

Smooth to slight, with a low swell developing.

Rain and drizzle, perhaps locally heavy, with mist and a risk of fog patches, clearing by dawn risk of isolated showers later.

Moderate, locally poor or very poor, becoming good later.

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
