Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most southern areas will have a dry day with some sunshine, and it will feel fresher than Sunday. There will be sunny spells and scattered showers in central and northern Britain. Showers will die out this evening with most places dry overnight. However, outbreaks of rain will spread across Northern Ireland into Scotland and western England and Wales by dawn.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be mainly cloudy with brisk winds and rain spreading from the west into central then eastern areas during the day. It will remain cool and breezy on Wednesday but rain will clear many areas with some sunshine developing.
