

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 15 Nov 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Northern Scotland broken cloud and scattered showers throughout, while southern Scotland and Northern Ireland remain largely cloudy and dry today, although some bright spells may occur. England and Wales will be generally cloudy, mild, with occasional light rain or drizzle in the west. Overnight remaining parts of Scotland will be dry, otherwise cloudy with outbreaks of light rain and drizzle.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday cloudy with outbreaks of rain across Northern Ireland, Wales, central England and parts of the southeast. Otherwise mainly dry, cloudy across southern areas, sunny spells across Scotland. Monday rain spreading east across the UK, except not reaching northern Scotland.
