Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Cloud and outbreaks of rain, locally heavy, across northern England and north Wales this morning, gradually becoming brighter with scattered showers. Elsewhere sunny intervals and scattered showers, after a dry and sunny start for many places, with early patchy fog soon clearing. Temperatures close to normal.

Scattered showers across western Scotland and northwest England overnight. Elsewhere isolated light showers and clear spells, becoming dry in many places, and chilly in rural locations.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday - sunny intervals and scattered showers, showers mainly in the west.

Thursday - rain spreading east across all areas, brighter weather and showers following from the west.
