

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 06 Jul 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Parts of Scotland will see persistent and occasionally heavy rain. Elsewhere, sunny intervals and scattered showers are expected, some heavy and thundery. Showers will later merge to longer spells of rain over southwestern UK, accompanied by strong winds. By evening, persistent rain in Scotland will finally abate, however bands of showers will persist overnight elsewhere, along with brisk winds.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Unsettled, with sunny spells and scattered showers occasionally turning heavy with thunder. Slow-moving showers are likely in parts of northwestern UK, but elsewhere brisk winds will move these through. Temperatures will be near or a little below average for July.
