




**Yellow warning  
Rain**

**22:00 Thu 14 Nov 2019**



**Further heavy rain may lead to further disruption and flooding.**

**What to expect**

- Further homes and businesses could be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- Fast flowing or deep floodwater is possible, causing a danger to life
- Spray and flooding could lead to difficult driving conditions and some road closures
- Some communities may be cut off by flooded roads
- Delays or cancellations to train and bus services are possible
- Possible power cuts and loss of other services to some homes and businesses

**Further details**

A period of heavy and persistent rain is likely on Thursday. 20-30 mm is likely fairly widely within the warning area and a few places may receive 30-40 mm which may lead to further flooding and disruption. This rain is expected to clear away northwards during the evening.

**Reason for update**

Warning area trimmed to reflect latest forecast information and time of cessation brought forward.
