Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mostly cloudy with outbreaks of rain or drizzle, locally heavy in the north.
Heavier rain will move southeast through the afternoon, becoming lighter and
more intermittent as it reaches the southeast. Clearer weather following with
blustery showers, particularly in the north and west. Strong southwesterly
winds, local gales in the north. Mild.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Showers, chiefly in the north and northwest becoming lighter and dying out in
the afternoon as patchy rain reaches Northern Ireland. Sunny spells elsewhere.
Winds decreasing. After a wet night in the north, rain will clear southeastwards
on Friday. England and Wales mostly cloudy and a wet afternoon.
