Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and rain, occasionally heavy, across northern and western parts, will become confined to northwest Scotland during the day. Warm sunshine will develop elsewhere, after a cloudy start. Windy everywhere, with a risk of gales in the north and west. Dry and very mild across the south and east overnight, but further rain across the west and north.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Heavy rain and strong winds across Scotland will clear eastwards on Saturday, with showers following on, heaviest across Northern Ireland and western Scotland. Plenty of sunshine for England and Wales. Sunny spells and scattered heavy showers on Sunday, and feeling somewhat cooler.
