

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be cloudy in the west and north of the United Kingdom today, with outbreaks of mostly light rain or drizzle. Central and eastern England will remain largely dry, but increasingly cloudy, and rather warm during the sunnier spells. Southeast winds will be fresh to locally strong in western and northern areas.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Cloud is expected on Sunday with some rain, locally heavy initially in western and then central areas, clearing from western parts later. On Monday, rain will persist in eastern Britain, but it will be dry in the west, and generally warm with lighter winds.
