

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Persistent rain, heavy at times, continuing across northern parts of England and Wales, leading to a risk of localised flooding. Sunny spells and scattered showers are expected elsewhere, though the showers could be heavy at times across southern counties. Rain continuing across northern England and Wales overnight, but easing towards dawn. Showery outbreaks of rain slowly easing elsewhere.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Outbreaks of rain clearing southeast Tuesday morning. Elsewhere will be drier and brighter, with scattered showers, mainly in the east. Showers turning wintry over the higher ground in the north as we head into Wednesday. Breezy both days and feeling much colder.
