Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Sunday will be rather cloudy with some rain, locally heavy and thundery in western and then central areas, perhaps clearing from western areas by evening. The southeast should remain mostly fine and dry until later, where it will be another rather warm day.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

On Monday, rain in eastern Britain will return towards central areas, tending to die out as it does so with the brightest weather likely in the far west. Tuesday will be mostly fine and sunny. It will become generally warm in many areas with lighter winds, although still rather chilly near some eastern coasts.
