Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Any patchy rain over southern parts of Britain at first will die out  
in the morning. Elsewhere, the chance of the odd light shower but for  
most a dry though rather cloudy day is expected with only a few  
bright or sunny intervals. However, some longer sunny periods are  
likely across northern and eastern parts later in the day.  
Temperatures near normal but feeling cool near east coasts.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Mostly dry and warmer with sunny periods and light winds although  
northwest Scotland may become cloudier with a little rain or drizzle  
on Wednesday, and coasts with sea breezes will feel cooler.
