Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It will be bitterly cold for many parts of the UK with temperatures struggling to rise above freezing. A band of rain, sleet and snow will spread east across the country during the course of the day, giving further small accumulations of snow, particularly over northern hills. Only southeast England is expected to remain dry.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday, some rain and hill snow will cross England and Wales, with snow showers further north. Thereafter, many areas should turn drier and brighter, but snow showers will continue in the far north of the UK. It will stay very cold, frosty and icy.
