Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Mild. Cloudy with outbreaks of sometimes-heavy, locally-persistent rain in Scotland and Northern Ireland, where it will be increasingly windy. Showers in Wales, northern and southwest England, but most eastern areas dry with sunny periods.  
Mostly dry, but mostly cloudy tonight, with some clear periods in eastern parts. Rain in Scotland and Northern Ireland becoming heavy and persistent. Windy in all areas, with gale to severe-gale-force winds in northwest Scotland later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain and gales will cross all areas on Tuesday, followed by sunny, then clear periods and showers. Gale-force winds at times on Wednesday with showers or longer outbreaks of rain.
