Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a largely dry morning with some brightness, heavy rain and strong winds will push north across southern England and South Wales through the afternoon. Elsewhere, largely dry but with scattered showers. Overnight, the rain will push northwards, reaching North Wales and northern England by dawn, with hill snow in places. Largely dry elsewhere with a frost in the north.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain and hill snow will move north on Thursday with brighter but showery weather following to the south. All parts will see sunny spells and showers on Friday with showers most frequent in the south. Staying rather cool and breezy.
