Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Northern and Central Scotland will be bright with sunny spells and occasional showers. Rain over Southern Scotland will move slowly south into Northern England and Northern Ireland. The remainder of England and Wales generally dry with some warm sunny spells developing but western areas will stay quite cloudy.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Much colder with rain spreading southwards during Saturday followed by wintry showers. Cold and windy on Sunday with sunshine and occasional showers. The showers locally heavy with hail, sleet and snow at times giving a temporary covering of snow in places. Several centimetres of snow with drifting are likely over northern hills.
