Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A dry day for most although a little drizzle is possible over parts of North Wales. The rest of Wales and much of England will see a lot of cloud but Scotland and N.Ireland should have some sunny spells, these reaching northern England during the day. Rather warm across southern parts but fresher in the north.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Dry for many on both Sunday and Monday, although rather cloudy over northern and western Britain. Mist and fog patches are possible overnight, only slowly clearing through the day. A narrowing and weakening band of rain will move south across northern Britain during Monday.
