Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southern and eastern Scotland, parts of northeastern England and eastern parts of Northern Ireland will have outbreaks of rain. Further south there will be scattered heavy showers with a risk of thunderstorms. Northwestern Scotland will have isolated showers. Tonight showers or longer spells of rain will sink southwards across England and Wales. Scotland and Northern Ireland will have isolated showers.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Further showery rain in parts of eastern England at first on Friday, but otherwise a day of sunshine and scattered showers, most of the showers falling in the north and east. Rain will spread eastwards to all areas during Saturday.
