

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Murky but mild for most, with extensive hill fog coupled with a little light rain and drizzle at times. Parts of northern UK will be drier and brighter, with early fog gradually clearing. Mist and fog will close in once more overnight for most, although the far north should stay clearer but colder, with some valley fog forming.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Most areas should stay rather cloudy through to midweek, with dull and damp conditions dominating, although it may become rather warm in any limited cloud breaks. It will be clearer in the far north with the best of any sunshine here.
