Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Much of England and Wales, cloudy with outbreaks of rain, sleet and increasingly snow. Some significant snow possible even at low levels, causing some travel disruption, combined with strengthening winds over southeastern areas. Scotland and Northern Ireland, mostly bright, heavy wintry showers, especially northeast Scotland. Rather cold or cold. Widespread overnight frost.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Sleet and snow clearing from far southeast England during Thursday then sunny spells and scattered wintry showers. Cloud and rain, preceded by snow spreading across northern parts later on Thursday, extending south across England and Wales during Friday followed by sunny spells and wintry showers. Mainly rather cold.
