Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A much drier day for many with some warm sunshine in the south and east.
However, rain will spread back into Northern Ireland, and scattered thundery showers will affect parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland. Windy in the north. Rain, showers and strong winds will tend to ease overnight, becoming confined to the north. Clear spells elsewhere.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A good deal of dry and fine weather with spells of sunshine on Monday. Strong winds in the north will ease. A few isolated showers are possible, most likely in the south. Generally a mixture of sunny spells and scattered showers on Tuesday.
