

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Parts of England and Wales starting quite cloudy, however this should break up with most places seeing some warm sunshine during the day. Cloud will however increase across Northern Ireland and western Scotland, introducing rain later this evening, some of which will be heavy. This will continue to move slowly eastwards overnight.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain, affecting many western areas, will move east and fragment on Monday, with southeast England probably staying dry, and warm. Heavy showers likely for Northern Ireland and western Scotland. Rain for southern England and south Wales on Tuesday, with scattered showers elsewhere. Generally breezy, with near average temperatures.
