Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland, rain persisting in the west but brighter in the east. Elsewhere, rain will slowly edge east across Northern Ireland, Wales and the western half of England becoming heavy for a time, although central and eastern England should be dry and bright for much of the day. Becoming windy with gales on coasts and hills and squally gusts inland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A brighter day on Monday with sunny spells, but still some a few showers, heavy at times, especially in the north. On Tuesday, wet and windy for a time with heavy rain sweeping east across most areas followed by squally showers.
