

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 03 Feb 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A very cold day across the UK, with temperatures barely rising above freezing.  
Some snow showers are likely in eastern England later, but otherwise it will be  
dry and largely sunny. Northern Ireland and western Scotland becoming cloudier  
with occasional light rain this afternoon and evening, continuing overnight.  
Another widespread frost is expected tonight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Many areas will experience a period of snow on Saturday or Saturday night, with  
some significant accumulations possible, although in Northern Ireland and  
western parts of Great Britain rain is more likely. On Sunday, southeast England  
still snowy at first, but elsewhere dry with some sunshine.
