Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It'll be a chilly start, with a risk of icy patches in north-east England.  
Otherwise it'll be mostly dry and bright today, but with occasional showers for some, which will turn heavy at times. These will ease during the evening, leaving a dry night, although some frost and fog patches are likely by the morning.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday there will be sunny spells for most, although it'll be cold. However, wet and windy weather will arrive in the west during the afternoon, and on Saturday this will move eastwards, bringing the damp, blustery conditions to the rest of the UK.
