Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be cloudy in places across England and Wales, but also with warm with sunny spells for most. Rain will affect Scotland and Northern Ireland, although possibly turning brighter and fresher in the far northwest later. Rain will edge southeastwards overnight. Staying dry, muggy and warm for many in England.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain will weaken and continue erratically southeastwards on Friday, perhaps preceded by heavy, thundery showers in the southeast, where hot and humid. Sunny spells and showers in the northwest later. Breezier, fresher but still pleasantly warm on Saturday with sunny spells and showers, heaviest most likely in the northwest.
