

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain and hill snow, initially across northeast Scotland, will turn increasingly to sleet and snow at lower levels, as it drifts southwards, reaching south Wales, the Midlands and East Anglia by dawn tomorrow. Ahead of this, frequent showers in western areas, some heavy with hail and turning wintry over high ground. Frost and ice developing overnight, where skies clear.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Plenty of sparkling winter sunshine on Wednesday, once early cloud and showers clear southern counties of England. However, wintry showers will continue to plague eastern coasts in particular. Rain, hill snow and brisk winds will spread to many areas on Thursday.
