

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 28 Dec 2006

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain and drizzle initially across Northern Ireland, north Wales, central England and East Anglia, moving northeast to reach southern Scotland and Northern England today. Elsewhere dry, sunny spells, once fog lifts across northeast England. South and west milder. Dry tonight, with patchy fog across northeast England, until rain moves east across Northern Ireland to reach other western areas.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday rain, across western areas at first, will continue east. Broken cloud and showers will follow to Northern Ireland, then later other western areas. Becoming milder but windy. Saturday sunshine and blustery showers, once rain quickly clears from eastern areas.
