

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 10 Feb 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A generally chilly start today, with some early fog patches, but once these clear most places will be dry and mild with plenty of prolonged sunshine. However, much of Scotland and N.Ireland will be more cloudy with some drizzle. Mostly dry, clear and cold tonight with light winds. Some mist and fog will develop along with a widespread frost.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:  
Conditions on both Monday and Tuesday should stay generally fine, dry and mild with plenty of sunshine and light winds. Some overnight fog patches may linger well into the day in sheltered spots though and chilly nights are likely to continue.
