Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Bright or sunny spells and showers for most, after low cloud and rain clears from southernmost counties of England. Showers will be heavy at times, with a risk of thunder, most frequent in the northwest. Windy, a risk of gales along the Channel coast. Showers dying away by evening but heavy showers returning to the northwest later. Staying quite windy.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Staying unsettled. Heavy, thundery showers will clear to the east on Tuesday morning leaving a drier prospect for the afternoon. Further rain or showers spreading from the southwest later. Further rain or showers spreading northeast on Wednesday. Windy at times.
