Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Today: a rather cloudy day with rain or showers for many parts, although Northern Ireland and some central and southeastern areas of England will have the best of any drier brighter weather. Temperature, near average, but feeling cool in the rainy southwest. Rain in S Wales/ S Midlands will extend to southeast England, while becoming light and patchy elsewhere. Risk of ground frost in northern Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday : patchy light rain over S Wales and southern England will clear away southwards, leaving a dry, but rather cloudy day, although coastal areas will have some sunshine.

Tuesday: dry and sunny for many areas, becoming warm inland.
