Headline:

Heavy rain and gales spreading southeastwards. Sunnier skies to follow.

Today:

Many places starting dry. Rain, locally heavy, spreading southeastwards, accompanied by gales, locally severe in the north. Sunnier skies and lighter winds following, reaching all but southeast England by dark.

Tonight:

Rain in the southeast clearing, then mostly dry and clear. Blustery showers in the windy north.

Outlook for Wednesday:

Rain or showers spreading eastwards on gale force winds. Becoming drier and quieter later.
