

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Saturday 10 Dec 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A frosty start, with icy stretches in the northwest. A cold day ahead with sunny spells. However, it will be cloudier across northern and western parts with showers, some wintry over northern hills. Rain and hill snow then spreading into northwestern parts in the evening, pushing southeastwards overnight. Remaining dry for southeast England with a patchy frost forming.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Heavy rain moving southeast throughout the day on Monday. Elsewhere, seeing sunny intervals and scattered showers. Showers often heavy in the northwest with hail and thunder with snow over northern hills. Drier and brighter on Monday with showers easing in the northwest.
