Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry with sunshine in the south-east, but cloudier further north and west, with rain, heavy in places, moving south-eastwards. Another cold day, and becoming a little breezier for most as well. Some scattered showers overnight. Milder than last night in the south, but still cold, with a risk of frost in the north.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Cold again on Friday with rain perhaps affecting the south coast at times. Heavy rain and showers for Scotland and north-west England and Wales, with isolated showers elsewhere. Saturday will be breezy, cold and bright. Mostly dry, but with showers on or around eastern and western coasts.
